On December 13, 2011, Mr. Ioan Bala, General Director of Romania's penitentiary system, visited MCC San Diego. Mr. Bala met with Warden Fernando A. Arriola and toured the institution. He was especially impressed with the variety of programs offered to the inmates. The visit was part of the U.S. Department of State's International Visitor Leadership Program.

FCC Florence

On January 19, 2012, FCC Florence hosted a visit by a delegation of officials from Brazil and the U.S. Department of State. The group is participating in a program to help improve the quality of prison management worldwide. The delegation met with Complex Warden Blake Davis and Warden Theresa Cozza-Rhodes and toured the FCI (Medium) facility; they were particularly interested in inmate classification, case management, intake screening, supervision, and reentry initiatives. The Brazilians were impressed with institution operations, staff professionalism, the Residential Drug Abuse Program, UNICOR operations and the many other programs available to the inmate population.

BOP Conflict Resolution Team Visits USP Atlanta

During the week of January 9 – 13, the Bureau's Conflict Resolution Team visited USP Atlanta. The Conflict Resolution Team, a component of the Bureau's Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Office, was established to assist staff and management resolve workplace disputes. Central Office EEO Officer Mina Raskin and Michael Meserve, Western Region Council of Prison Locals Vice President, met with USP Atlanta's executive staff, the local union president, and several staff members to discuss workplace issues.

FPC Pensacola Hosts Mentoring Program Training

On January 12, FPC Pensacola Warden Scott A. Middlebrooks and members of his staff held Mentor Training for 45 Reentry Court staff and volunteers from the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Florida. The Reentry Court, overseen by The Honorable M. Casey Rodgers, Chief Judge for the Northern District of Florida, is incorporating a mentoring component to assist federal offenders with their transition back to the community. The Reentry Court Program is being evaluated as part of a long-term research study being conducted by the School of Justice Studies and Social Work at the University of West Florida.

Participants included Judge Rodgers; The Honorable Miles Davis, Magistrate Judge; Mark Cook, Chief U.S. Probation Officer; Steve Pridgen, Supervisory U.S. Probation Officer, who serves as the court's mentor coordinator; Warden Middlebrooks; Chaplain Neal Milligan; Reentry Affairs Coordinator Bianca Freeman and mentor volunteers. Myra Lowery, Southeast Regional Reentry Affairs Administrator, facilitated a session titled "A Guide for Mentoring Ex-Offenders" that included a history of mentoring, the mentoring relationship, communication, resources and activities. Instructor Len Anderson, along with U.S. Probation Officers Russ Szafran and Brian Davis, facilitated presentations on post-conviction risk assessment,

cognitive behavior therapy, and relapse prevention plans.

FCI Mendota Holds Open House

On January 18, FCI Mendota Warden Paul Copenhaver and his staff provided a tour of the institution for local media representatives. The purpose was to familiarize the media with the institution's operations and programs prior to the arrival of the first medium security inmates. The visitors were impressed with the institution's mission, design, and security features.

On January 19, FCI Mendota held an open house for members of the community. More than 500 local residents, including staff families, received an overview of the institution's operations and the programs that will be available to the inmates. The guests were complimentary of staff and their professionalism.

Staff Serve the Community

FCI Herlong

On December 15, 2011, David Haggard, FCI Herlong Utility Systems Repairer Operator Supervisor, was among the first to arrive at the scene of a car accident in Reno, Nevada. The vehicle had experienced mechanical failure and crashed through the wall of a classroom while school was in session. Fortunately, no teachers or children were injured. Mr. Haggard, the Family Services Center Manager for FCI Herlong's Crisis Support Team, assessed the scene and provided crisis support until emergency personnel arrived.

MCFP Springfield

In mid-January, Willie D. Butler, III, MCFP Springfield Senior Officer Specialist, observed a pickup truck moving slowly through an intersection. Officer Butler could not see anyone in the vehicle; however, as his vehicle neared the truck, he could see an elderly man slouched over in the seat. When the vehicle came to a stop, Officer Butler and another passerby checked on the man and, finding no pulse,

called 911 and began CPR. When emergency personnel arrived at the scene, they were able to detect a pulse and treat the man, who then started breathing on his own.
