FCI El Reno: A Look Back at its Early Years

FCI El Reno will be celebrating its 80th Anniversary soon – the following is a brief look back at its early years:



Federal Reformatory, El Reno, then....

Originally named the United States Southwestern Reformatory (abbreviated “U.S.S.R.”), FCI El Reno was the Bureau’s second institution for younger “improvable” male offenders. Located on the site of a former Army Remount Depot, the original facility cost approximately \$1 million to build and included an administration building, receiving building, and four dormitories that could accommodate 760 inmates. Only 50 percent of the staff (36 people) had been hired by April 4, 1933, when the first 199 inmates were transferred from USP Leavenworth, Kansas, the Federal Reformatory, Chillicothe, Ohio, and the Federal Prison Camp at Camp Riley, Kansas.

The institution’s farm began with 60 horses and mules, and 54 pigs; over time, teams of oxen and a dairy herd were added. The 750 acre farm operated on the “back to the land” philosophy – farming without motorized equipment. Within the first year, the farm, consisting of corn and prairie hay crops, employed 200 inmates.

Mission of the Bureau of Prisons
It is the mission of the Federal Bureau of Prisons to protect society by confining offenders in the controlled environments of prisons and community-based facilities that are safe, humane, cost-efficient, and appropriately secure, and that provide work and other self-improvement opportunities to assist offenders in becoming law-abiding citizens.

In 1938, the farm produced 66 tons of hay, 11,000 bushels of grain, 67,000 pounds of pork, 45,000 gallons of milk, 17,000 bushels of vegetables, 11,000 pounds of potatoes, and more!

In addition to the farm, other industries included a broom factory (that supplied the needs of all federal government agencies), a weaving mill that produced cotton toweling, wool suit fabric, and blanket material, and a printing factory.

In 1938, the institution became the Federal Reformatory, El Reno, Oklahoma. By the late 1960's, the facility had become a medium security Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) for young adults, ages 18-26. Then, in the late 1970's, its mission changed again when it began housing adult offenders of all ages.
