## Bureau Holds First Reentry Affairs Coordinators Training

In May, the National Reentry Affairs Branch (NRB) held its first Reentry Affairs Coordinator training in Denver, Colorado. Staff participating (in person or via video-conference) included Kathryn Tracy, Senior Deputy Assistant Director, Correctional Programs Division; administrators from the Central Office divisions and UNICOR; Regional Reentry Affairs Administrators; more than 100 Bureau Reentry Affairs Coordinators, and the NRB staff.

Training topics focused on evidence-based programs, program linkage, the Inmate Skills Development System, the role of various disciplines within Reentry, partnerships, volunteers, and available resources. During the training, participants had the opportunity to network with each other and were able to share their valuable insights regarding reentry strategies and practices.

The Reentry Affairs Coordinators were recognized for their work and for promoting the agency's reentry strategies. As noted at the training, "The BOP Road to Reentry Begins on the Day of Incarceration," and all staff play an integral part in the successful reintegration of offenders back into society.

## USP McCreary Hosts FBI Hostage Negotiation Training

On June 6, Special Agent Lori Greenwell, FBI Crisis Negotiations Team Coordinator and member of the Joint Terrorism Task Force, visited USP McCreary and facilitated hostage negotiation training for the institution's Crisis Management Team (CMT). Topics included sessions on active listening skills and incident assessment, and mock training scenarios. The training provided CMT staff an opportunity to enhance their skills and strengthen their partnership with the FBI.
