## FCI Ashland Participates in Reentry Council Planning Session

On July 11, FCI Ashland held its first planning session to develop a Reentry Council in northeastern Kentucky. Once finalized, it will be the 11<sup>th</sup> Reentry Council in the State of Kentucky. The interagency meeting included participants from the Kentucky Reentry Taskforce and local community leaders. One of the primary goals of the council will be to educate the community about needs of ex-offenders and the importance of helping them make a successful transition back into the community.

## FCI Loretto Holds Reentry Programs

On July 26, FCI Loretto Reentry Affairs Coordinator Matt Butler facilitated the institution's quarterly "Incarcerated Veterans" program. A representative from the Department of Veterans Affairs in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, met with inmates to share information and register qualified veterans for medical benefits upon release.

On the same day, the Education Department, in conjunction with Reentry Affairs Coordinator Matt Butler, held a mock job fair for inmates who have completed an Employment Skills course. Community volunteers conducted practice interviews with inmates and provided feedback regarding their resumes and interview skills. Agencies participating in the job fair included the United States Probation Office for the Western District of Pennsylvania; Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry; Mount Aloysius College; Renewal Incorporated; the Greater Altoona Career and Technical Center, and local small businesses.

## USP Atlanta Holds Mock Job Fair

On July 26, USP Atlanta Education Department staff sponsored a mock job fair focusing on workforce re-

integration and reentry. Inmates had the opportunity to connect with local employers, participate in practice interviews conducted by community partners, and learn about accessibility to community resources. The volunteers were impressed with how well-prepared the inmates were and how they answered the interview questions.
